



#### **HS2 and Greater Birmingham**




- Greater Birmingham area at heart of the UK network
- Benefit from:
  - City Centre Terminus
  - Interchange station
  - Depot
- Importance of connectivity north and south

#### The arrival of HS2



- Terminus station
- Birmingham to London 49 minutes
- Bring significant investment unlocking regeneration and development potential
- Construction starts 2017
- First passenger service 2026


### Birmingham Curzon HS2 masterplan



- 141 hectares in heart of City Centre
- Covering
  - eastern fringe of the City Centre Core
  - Eastside
  - Digbeth
- Integrated approach
  - Station
  - Wider regeneration

- Delivered through clear programme of activity


# **The Regeneration Company**

#### **Creating a Development Zone**



- Covered by the Enterprise Zone
- Business rates relief
- Local Development Orders
- Dedicated Planning and Development support
- Infrastructure and Delivery Fund
- Marketing and promotion
- Role of the Regeneration Company



#### **Birmingham Curzon**

- HS2 HQ (Construction) will be relocated from London to Birmingham within the Enterprise Zone. 1,500 jobs created and approximately 100,000 sq ft let
- Launch a Regeneration Company to take forward the Curzon Masterplan.
- £30m approved by the Greater Birmingham and Solihull Local Enterprise Partnership to the Regeneration Company to deliver infrastructure to support development activity across the Birmingham Curzon area
- Investment of £140m to extend the Midland Metro from Snowhill Station to the location of the new HS2 terminus at Birmingham Curzon all the way down to Adderley Park.
