Why buses are vital to the Liverpool City Region (LCR)

- 147m bus passenger journeys per year in LCR
- 80% of public transport journeys by bus despite a thriving local rail network
- Locally, buses are critical to economic growth, social capacity and access to education

Because of this, it is critical that the long term trend of patronage decline was reversed









LCR Bus Alliance

The Alliance has achieved a number of improvements since its inception, including:

- £52m + investment in new buses for the LCR
- Ticketing improvements including multi-operator day ticket and scrapping zonal fares system
- Improved customer information at bus stops
- One smart card platform for the LCR
- Newly designed customer service training course for all drivers
- Improved links to John Lennon Airport and new 24/7 services
- Young Persons Fare Deal

16.5% growth in fare paying passengers

142% growth in young persons journeys

90% customer satisfaction

Over £50m invested in the bus offer
