

Current



Car travel is the dominant mode of travel (66% of all trips and 80% by distance)

Future

Total demand is forecast to increase by up to 54%



1.1% share of total trips (9% by distance)Rail passengers three times more than 20 years ago.

Total demand is expected to be up to four times higher than today by 2050.






Developing the major strategic transport interventions along economic growth corridors

SRN Enhancements including RIS1 carry over	£20 billion	£5.7 billion
SRN Maintenance and Renewals	£5 billion	£1.4 billion
MRN	£3.5 billion	£1.0 billion



TfN INVESTMENT PROGRAMME

TfN Board agreed an initial list of SRN/MRN interventions for the RIS2 period in September 2017 as part of a long term Investment Programme

For the **SRN**:

- Interventions 2020 2027, estimated cost of £4.4 billion
 For the MRN:
- Interventions 2020 2027, estimated cost of £1.2 billion

The emerging Investment Programme for Strategic Roads is therefore **ambitious but realistic**
